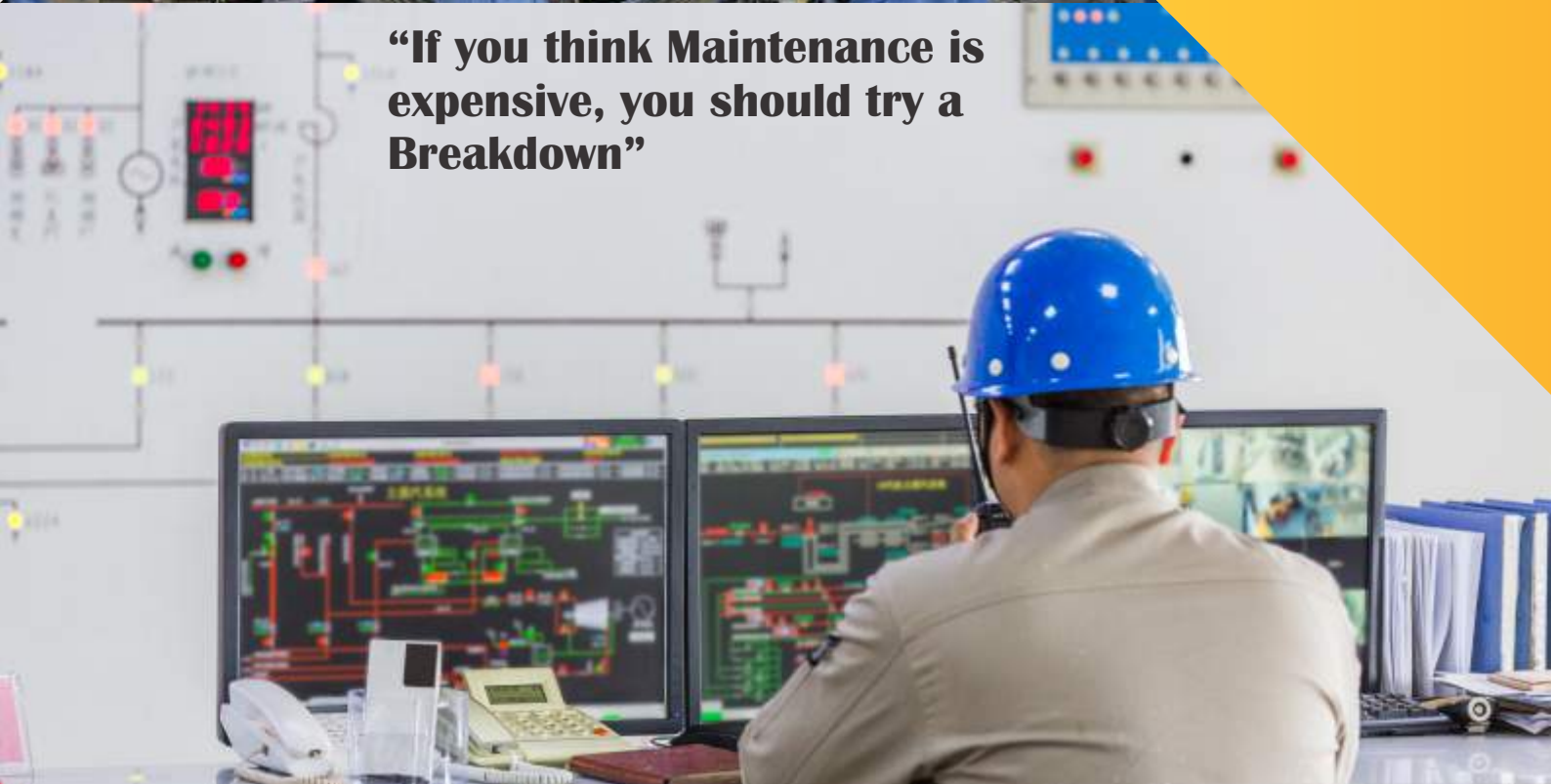

TPM aims at reducing and eliminating losses and costs in manufacturing in Level I & Level II as it helps the businesses in reducing their Supply Chain costs and then TPM is extended from supply chain to all functions in order to generate cash.

It is estimated that companies implementing JIPM - TPM can get return as high as 8 to 10 times their investment on TPM over 3 years or so from the records of awarded companies .

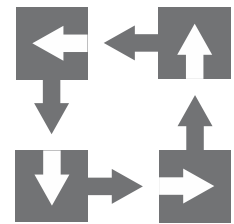
Who should take this Masterclass?
